the petitioners and Sri Narendra Kumar Singh, learned Addl.

Two petitioners, who are named as accused in

Rampur P.S. Case No.105/16 registered for the offence under

Sections 147,148, 149, 341, 323, 353, 427, 379, 342, 337, 307 of

the Indian Penal Code, have prayed for grant of bail in the event of

their arrest.

It was submitted by learned counsel for the

petitioners that as per F.I.R. itself, a mob have committed

occurrence and the police officials were admittedly not in police

dress, they were assaulted. He further submits that on perusal of

the F.I.R, offence under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code is not made out. On the aforesaid ground, learned counsel for the petitioners has made a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.

Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

I have perused the materials on record including the F.I.R. On perusal of the F.I.R. it is evident that the petitioners are named accused. In view of nature of accusation, I do not find any ground to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The petition stands dismissed.
