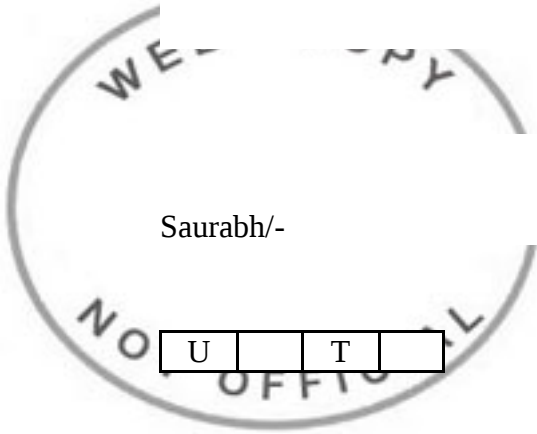
In such view of the matter, it cannot be said that the amendment sought for prejudiced the petitioner in any way nor it occasioned failure of justice.
