At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner makes a prayer for allowing him to make correction in paragraph-1 of the petition. He submits that due to typographical mistake, instead of mentioning "N.D.P.S.Act", it has been typed as "IPC".

The prayer is allowed.

It may be done in course of the day.

Heard Sri Shri Prakash Srivastava, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Damodar Prasad Tiwary, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The sole petitioner, who is in custody since 23.08.2016 in Majhauria P.S. Case No.233 of 2016, corresponding to G.R. Case No.14 of 2016 registered for the offence under Sections 20 and 22 of the N.D.P.S.Act, has prayed for grant of



bail.

It was submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the so called recovered Ganja is much lesser than the smaller quantity. He submits that total 237 gms of Ganja was recovered.

Considering much lesser than the smaller quantity of recovered Ganja, let the petitioner, namely, Niten Sil @ Nipen Sil be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge, West Champaran, Bittiah in connection with Majhaulia P.S. Case no.233/2016.
