By way of the present application preferred under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution, the petitioners seek quashing of the first information report of Muffasil P.S. Case No. 661 of 2013 dated 27.10.2013 registered under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

I have heard counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State and perused the FIR as contained in Annexure- 1 to the present application. The allegations made therein do attract

the ingredients of the offence punishable under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.
