Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 153/147 of the Railway Act.

According to the F.I.R., the petitioner was crossing the railway line on a motorcycle. The petitioner saw the train coming, then left his motorcycle and fled away.

Submission of the petitioner is that in fact to save his life the petitioner anyhow escaped and in fact looser is the petitioner because his motorcycle was crushed.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the



Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Railway Judicial Magistrate, Sonapur, Saran/Successor Court in connection with Muzaffapur R.P.F. Case No.634 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
