2 14-12-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420/406/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that the informant had taken settlement of fishery and she had deposited the settlement amount in four installments with the petitioners but the petitioners did not grant receipt.

Submission of the petitioners is that when the petitioner served notice on the informant regarding non-deposit of the settlement amount, the present false case has been lodged just to pressurize.

Considering the facts of the case aforesaid, let the



petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Mr. Ramesh Kumar, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Begusarai/Successor Court in connection with Chandpura Police Station Case No.53 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
