2 20-01-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Maner P.S. Case No.318 of 2015 for allegedly having committed the offences under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 324, 307 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that so far as Petitioner No.1 is concerned, he is a retired employee of the State Bank of India whereas Petitioner Nos.2 and 3 are students of medicines studying at Patna Medical College & Hospital and Nalanda Medical College & Hospital, respectively, and are pursuing their careers. Learned counsel

for the petitioners further submits that the present case is one of land dispute between own brothers and the present case was initiated only to take wreak vengeance so that career prospects of these petitioner are marred. It is further submitted that the petitioners are willing to co-operate with the investigation and also attend the court, as and when required.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and also that there is only one case against these petitioners filed by the same informant, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, in connection with Maner P.S. Case No.318 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
