5 27-07-2016 The petitioner is husband of the deceased.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the First Information Report has been instituted by the informant on the instigation of others. He has also submitted that there was no demand of dowry at any point of time.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the informant has submitted that the informant does not have any objection if the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail.

Considering the submissions as above, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, Akhilendra Yadav, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be

released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Biraul, Darbhanga, in connection with Kusheshwar Asthan Police Station Case No. 241 of 2015, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
