been recovered from the house of the petitioner but submission on
behalf of the petitioner is that the aforesaid recovery has not been

members of the petitioner and, as a matter of fact, nothing has
been recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be
released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional
Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sherghati at Gaya in connection with
Sherghati P.S.Case No. 325 of 2015.
