Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner seeks quashing of the order as
contained in Memo No. 163 dated 19.05.2016 passed by
the Sub-divisional Officer, Sadar, Siwan by which the
licence of the petitioner granted for running the public
distribution shop being licence no. 1151 of 2007 has
been cancelled.

However, the petitioner has approached this
Court without availing statutory remedy of appeal.

Accordingly, this writ application is being

disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to move before the appellate authority for redressal of his grievance as this writ application has been filed without availing the provision of statutory appeal. If such appeal is filed before the competent authority, let the same be considered and decided within a period of thirty days without going into the issue of limitation.
