Petitioners are looking for regularization. They have pleaded discrimination. It is their case that they have been working on daily wages for more than 33 years. Benefit of regularization has been extended to some but petitioners are still languishing hoping for a suitable response. Since it did not come, they filed the writ application.

In the counter affidavit filed on behalf of the respondents

they take a plea in paragraph 8 that the claim of these petitioners for absorption would be considered in the next meeting of the District Selection Committee of Nalanda.

The writ application is disposed of with a direction upon the District Magistrate- cum- Chairman that the decision on the status of the petitioners must be taken within a period of three months from the date of production of a copy of this order by convening a meeting.
