Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a
case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
366/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Accusation is of kidnapping the wife of the
informant along with ornaments and cash Rs. 2,50,000/-.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the
petitioner that for the occurrence of 07.09.2015 the First
Information Report was registered on 09.09.2015 and the
victim in 164 Cr.P.C. statement stated that due to torture of the
informant and her mother-in-law she left house.

Considering the fact that the victim has not named
the petitioner in 164 Cr.P.C. statement and statement has been

made in para-3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the above named petitioner be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sri R.K. Singh, J.M., Bagaha, West Champaran in connection with Laukariya P.S. Case No. 96 of 2015, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
