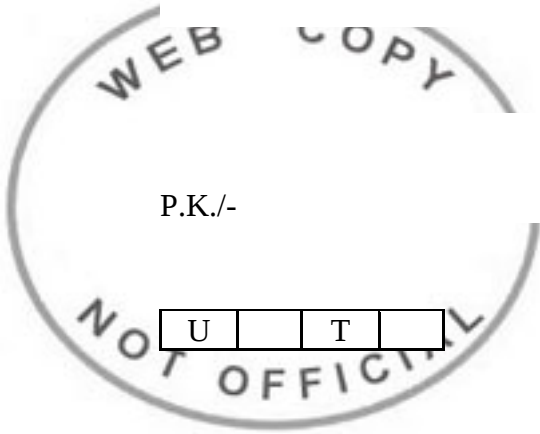
State.
