2 22-07-2016 Heard Mr. Vijay Kumar in support of the application.

The award passed by the learned Arbitrator under the provisions of the National Highways Authority Act (for short “The Act”) is under challenge. Diverse submissions have been made to assail the Arbitral Award. The Court is, however, reluctant to consider those submissions, as according to the provisions of the Act, any such Arbitral Award can be challenged under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. In case, the petitioner chooses to file appropriate proceeding for

setting aside the Arbitral Award impugned in the writ application, he may seek condonation of delay of the period for which the writ petition remained pending on the file of this Court. The prayer is declined.

The writ application is disposed of.
