Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks revision of the order dated 25.2.2015 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Gopalganj, in Criminal Appeal No. 20 of 2015 upholding the order dated 22.12.2014 passed by the Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) Gopalganj, in J.E. Case No. 05 of 2014.
