By way of present application under Articles 226
and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner seeks quashing of the
first information report of Vigilance P.S. Case No. 10 of 2015
registered under sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 479(A)/34 and
120(B) of the Indian Penal Code and sections 12(1)(d) and 13(2) of
the Prevention of Corruption Act.

It has been contended by the learned counsel for the
petitioner that though the petitioner is named in the first information
report, till date no incriminating material has been collected by the
investigating agency against him.

Learned counsel for the Vigilance has contended that the allegations made in the first information report are quite serious and investigation is still in progress.

Be that as it may, I have perused the allegations made in the first information report. The allegations do attract ingredients of a cognizable offence. The investigation of a criminal case is confidential in nature. Hence, the contention of the petitioner that no incriminating material has been collected against him till date is misconceived. Moreover, in the first information report itself serious allegations of financial irregularities have been levelled against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, I find no merit in the present application. Accordingly, the application is dismissed.
