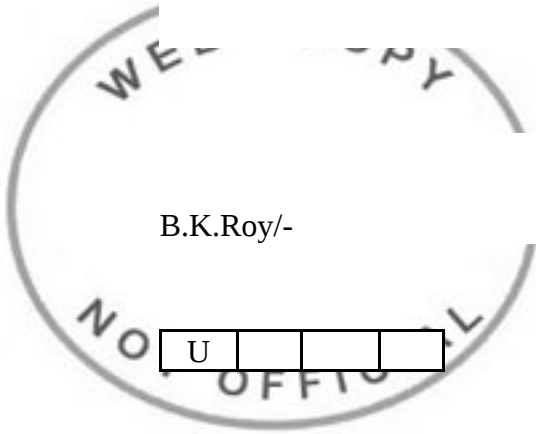
The petitioner renews his prayer for bail. He is an accused in a case under sections 364, 302 and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code in relation to Malaypur P.S. Case No. 29/2013. It is not in dispute that upon the confessional statement of the petitioner, the dead body of the kidnapped person was recovered.

In view of the aforesaid, I am not inclined to reconsider the matter.

Learned counsel points out that two other co-accused have been granted bail by this Court. I have perused those orders. Those two accused persons were named by this petitioner in his confessional statement; otherwise there is no material against them. That is why this Court was persuaded to grant them bail.

The case is clearly distinguishable.

The application is rejected. Let the trial be expedited.
