Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the  
offences punishable under Sections 419, 420 of the Indian Penal  
Code and Section 7 of E.C. Act.

Near about 200 litres K. Oil kept in two separate  
drums were recovered from a pickup van which was being driven  
by the petitioner no. 1 at the time of alleged recovery whereas  
petitioner no. 2 was working as Khalasi on the aforesaid pickup  
van. Petitioners are in jail custody since 15.01.2016 and they do  
not have any criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-IV, Hajipur, Vaishali in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No. 22 of 2016.
