Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since 19.12.2015 in a case registered for the offences punishable under sections 399, 402, 415 of the IPC, under Section 25(1-b)A of Arms Act and under Section 20/22 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

The prosecution case is that six miscreants were intercepted while travelling on two Pulsar motor cycles. From the possession of other miscreants arms, ammunition and 2.5 Kg. of Ganja were recovered. From the possession of the petitioner one Nokia mobile was recovered.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that neither arms nor Ganja was recovered from the petitioner, hence, none of the alleged offences are made out against the petitioner and only on suspicion the petitioner has been roped in this case. The investigation has already been concluded.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Bidupur P.S. Case No. 525 of 2015.
