2 14-06-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This is a petition for anticipatory bail for the offence
under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

The allegation is that in course of inspection the
P.D.S. shop of the petitioner was found closed which was opened
by the son of the petitioner in which 26 bags wheat and 12 bags
rice were found.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only
suspicion has been raised against the petitioner.

However, having regard to the facts and
circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the
event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within four

weeks from today be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M.-6th, Gaya, in Alipur P.S.Case No.17/16 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.
