 This writ application has been filed complaining that the

petitioner, who is the widow of an employee of the Patna Municipal

Corporation, has not been paid the family pension. It has been also

evident from Annexure 5 that a petition in this regard has been filed

by the petitioner before the Executive Engineer.

 Learned Counsel for the Corporation has taken a fair

stand that if the petitioner would be entitled to the family pension and

other benefits the same would be paid to her in accordance with law

without any further delay.

Accordingly, this writ application is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos. 3 and 4 to pass appropriate order for payment of admissible dues to the petitioner in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
