By way of the present application preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks quashing of the first information report (for short "FIR") of Vigilance P. S. Case No. 50 of 2015 registered under Sections 7/13(2) read with Section 13(i)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner

and perused the FIR as contained in Annexure- 1 to the present application. The allegations made therein do attract the ingredients of a cognizable offence.
