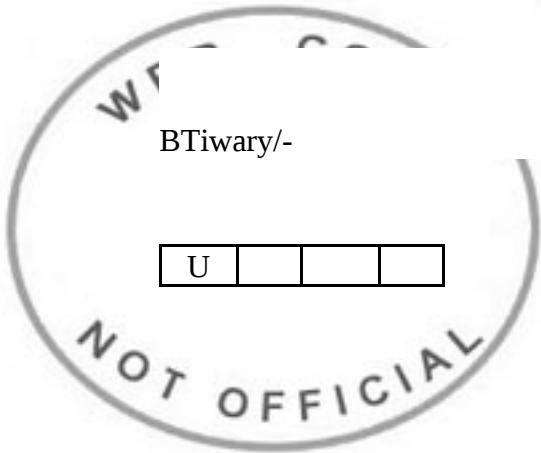
In view of nature of claims raised on behalf of the petitioner with respect to the lands in question, fully detailed in paragraph-4 of the writ petition, after some argument, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, in presence of the learned AC to SC-19, appearing on behalf of the respondents, seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to approach the appropriate authority/ civil court of competent jurisdiction for grant of appropriate relief(s) with respect to the lands in question claimed by the petitioner.

Permission is accorded.

The writ petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

It is clarified that this Court has not gone into the merits of the claims raised on behalf of the petitioner with respect to the lands in question and this is left to be decided by the statutory authority or the civil court of competent jurisdiction, as the case may be, strictly in accordance with law, but before passing any

final order, opportunity of hearing must be given to all concerned.
