ORAL ORDER

2 29-09-2016 Heard Mr. Dilip Kumar No.1, learned Counsel, appearing on behalf of the petitioner, and Md. Nadim Seraj, learned Government Pleader No.5, appearing on behalf of the State-respondents.

Having regard to the fact that though the petitioner has made allegations against the police officials of acting in collusion with the accused, the petition is completely vague and does not, therefore, warrant invocation of extraordinary

jurisdiction of the High Court, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

While, accordingly, allowing the writ petition, as sought for, to be withdrawn, we give the petitioner liberty to lodge, if so advised, a *First Information Report* with jurisdictional police station or file a complaint in the criminal court of competent jurisdiction.

If a *First Information Report* is lodged or the complaint is filed, the same shall be dealt with expeditiously and in accordance with law.

With the above observation, this writ petition stands disposed of as withdrawn.
