ORAL ORDER

3 20-12-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned APP.

During course of tender, informant, Kamal Sethi being representative of C/O M/S Bom Infra B-201, Nehru Ground, Faridabad, Haryana was participating. At that very time, one Chhotu Kumar claiming himself to be brother of Ritlal Yadav along with others having duly armed approached and threatened the informant that in case Rs. 80 Lacs is not paid as Rangdaari, he will not be able to get the tender, contrary to it, they will be eliminated. After registration of the case as is evident, the charge-sheet had already been submitted against some of the accused keeping the investigation pending and during course thereof, it is evident that at subsequent occasion different accused persons were arrested from the said spot out of whom one Sanjeev Kumar had confessed and the name of the petitioner transpired therein, on



account thereof, he has been made an accused against whom, supplementary charge-sheet has been submitted keeping the investigation pending.

Virtually, no legal evidence has been collected by the Investigating Officer against the petitioner save and except inculpatory extra-judicial confessional statement of a co-accused coupled with the fact that petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as per para-3 of the petition. Other co-accuse has also been released on bail.

Accordingly, petitioner, Jai Prakash is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna in Pirbahore PS Case No. 90/2016.
