The writ application being very sketchy and superficial in pleadings, no relief or direction can be issued in favour of the petitioner. Petitioner has herself annexed a copy of the Pension Payment Order. The issues, like, G.P.F., Group Insurance and Gratuity will not remain pending. The writ application has been, therefore, filed looking for some kind of a windfall, therefore, no relief can be granted.
