The writ application was filed for a direction upon the
respondents to scrutinize the copy of the Intermediate
Mathematics subject of the son of the petitioner no.1 for which
examination was held on 18.02.2015 and to provide the mark
sheets obtained thereat.

Mr. Manish Kumar produces a photo copy of the

certificate issued by the respondent-Board disclosing therein that petitioner no.2 obtained 76 marks in the Mathematics subject.
