ORAL ORDER

the petitioner and Sri Madan Kumar, learned Addl. Public

Prosecutor.

The sole petitioner, invoking inherent jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, has approached this Court with a prayer to quash an order dated 27.09.2013 passed by learned Adhoc Addl. Sessions Judge 1st , Muzaffarpur in Sessions Trial No.510 of 2012 arising out of Sakra P.S. Case No.431 of 2009 registered for the offence under Section 304B, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code. By the said order, the learned court below has rejected the discharge petition filed under Section 227 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the

death of the victim has occurred due to snake bite, however, a colour of poisoning was given. On this very ground, he has made a prayer for quashing the impugned order.

Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor, by way of referring to F.I.R. itself, submits that in the F.I.R. there is specific accusation against the petitioner and others regarding torture and demand of dowry.

In view of facts and circumstances, I do not find any ground to interfere with the impugned order. The petition stands dismissed.
