Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case instituted under Sections 302, 201 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners is that they might have killed son of the informant.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they have been falsely implicated in the present case. From perusal of the F.I.R. it is evident that merely on the basis of suspicion petitioners have been named in the present case. There is no eye witness to the alleged occurrence nor there is any circumstantial evidence to suggest implication of the petitioners in the present case.

On behalf of the State and the informant, it is submitted that petitioners are named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners, in the event of arrest or surrender in the court below within a period of six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri
