learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Section 147 of Rail Act and Section
47(A) of the Excise Act.

In huge quantity, Mahua liquor were recovered from
break-van of a passenger train. So far as petitioner is concerned,
he as well as another accused were caught by the informant and
other officials while they were trying to flee from the above stated
break-van of train. Petitioner is in jail custody since 13.03.2016
and does not have any criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as
well as submissions of the parties, particularly, this aspect of the

matter that no recovery has been made from conscious possession of the petitioner, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Railway Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Gaya Rail P.S. Case No. 29 of 2016.
