Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Limited grievance has been raised by the petitioner that though by a Notification, vide order dated 03.09.2005, the petitioner has been granted the benefit of Time Bound Promotion, but the monetary benefit has not been extended to him.

In paragraph 7 of the counter affidavit, it has been stated that the Director Agriculture, vide Memo. No. 815 dated 23.05.2013, has already intimated the District Magistrate, Patna to dispose of the claim of the petitioner and file a counter affidavit in this case.

The District Magistrate, Patna is directed to examine the Notification dated 3.9.2005 by which, it appears that, the petitioner has been given the benefit of Time Bound Promotion. When already a Notification has been issued thereby the petitioner has been granted the benefit of Time Bound Promotion, why the consequential benefit has not been extended to him.

This petition is disposed of with a direction if the petitioner has not been granted the consequential benefit as yet, the District Magistrate will examine his Office Order dated 3.9.2005 and take an action in accordance with law.

The petitioner has raised a grievance with regard to A.C.P.. If the petitioner is entitled to A.C.P., it goes without saying that he should be given aforesaid benefit within a period of three months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
