3 03-03-2016 Heard Sri Rajani Ranjan Prasad Singh, learned counsel

for the petitioner, Sri Jharkhandi Upadhyaya, learned A.P.P. as

well as Sri Madanjeet Kumar, learned counsel, who has

voluntarily appeared on behalf of the informant.

In the present petition the petitioner has prayed for
quashing of the order of cognizance dated 9.1.2013 passed by
learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur, Ara in connection
with Ara town P.S. Case No. 81 of 2010. By the said order the
learned Magistrate has taken cognizance of offence under Section
302, 120(B)/ 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

At the very outset, Sri Madanjeet Kumar, learned
counsel the informant submits that after the order of cognizance
many subsequent developments have taken place in the case. He
