Heard parties.

Admittedly the vigilance case is still pending and the S.L.P. filed against the order of the Division Bench has already been dismissed with a direction that vigilance enquiry shall be completed expeditiously and the petitioner would be at liberty to approach the High Court so that needful can be done for posting of a presiding officer. In my view, no order for payment of leave encashment amount can be passed if such inquiry or criminal proceeding is still pending.

However, the presiding officer which is in the seisin of the matter would be required to proceed expeditiously and take all the steps for early disposal of the trial which is the mandate of the Apex Court also.

This application stands disposed of.
