Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for
offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 354(B), and 379/34
of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 (Prevention of
Witchcraft), Act.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner is the own *Bhainsur* (elder brother-in-law) and whatever
that has been alleged against him could not be expected from a
Bhainsur. He has been implicated in the present due to existing
family dispute and the whole prosecution case is false and
concocted.

Having heard both sides and in view of the accusations levelled against the petitioner in the First Information Report, I am not inclined to grant the petitioner, the prayer for bail, it is accordingly rejected.

However, if the petitioner surrenders before the Court below within a period of four weeks, his prayer for regular bail may be considered by the learned Court below on its own merit, without being prejudiced by this order.
