This application, under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is directed against the order dated 30.07.2013 passed in Criminal Revision No.473 of 2012, whereunder the Additional Sessions Judge-I, Araria, dismissed the aforesaid Criminal Revision of the second party/petitioners, affirming the order dated 22.11.2012 passed in Case No.188M of 2012 in a proceeding under Section 107 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, whereunder the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Forbesganj, ordered under Section 116(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure to the second party/petitioners to

execute an interim bond of Rs.2000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to maintain the peace.

3. From perusal of the impugned orders, I find no illegality calling for interference with the same in an extra ordinary jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of this Court. Accordingly, this application stands dismissed.
