whereas Opp.Party no.2 has already entered appearance.

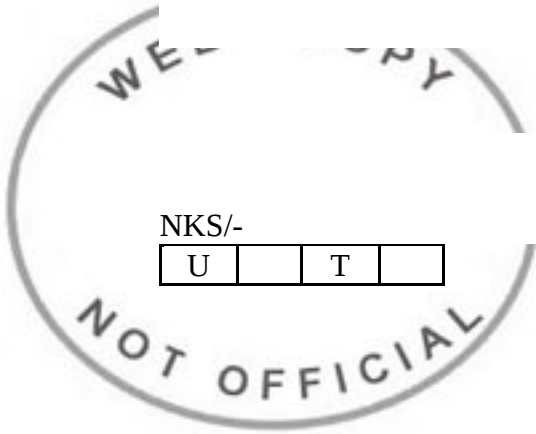
Sri Mukul Prasad, learned counsel for the
