The petitioners have assailed the legality and validity of the impugned order passed by the Labour Court directing payment of Rs.1,42,160/- to the respondents in execution of the award passed on 24.8.1998 in case No.14/ID Act/ Reference/93 (Shri Niranjan Singh & 37 others Vs. Conservator of Forest, Department of

Forest, Durg).

2. The Writ Petition preferred by the State against the award dated 24.8.1998 has been dismissed today in W.P. No.2747/2004. In the said Writ Petition, Shri T.K. Tiwari, Advocate had appeared on behalf of the workmen to submit that entire payment has been made to the workmen.
