3. Be that as it may, if the petitioner files fresh representation to respondent No.5-District Education Officer along with the order dated 20.6.2011 passed by this Court in W.P. (S) No.3135/2011, it is expected from respondent No.5 to decide the same as early as possible preferably within a period of 45 days from the receipt thereof.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands finally disposed of.
