Grievance of the petitioner is that though the petitioner had moved an application dated 17.08.2015 before respondent No.2 for grant of permanent stage carriage permit on the route Ranchi to Duldula via Saraitola, Kotba and back one return trip daily, the application has remained pending without any decision.
