(3) At this stage, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be allowed to prefer an appeal before the appellate authority within two weeks from today.

(4) The prayer appears to be fair and reasonable.

(5) The petitioner is permitted to prefer an appeal before the appellate authority. If such appeal is filed by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today, the appellate authority shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law and on its own merit preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the appeal along with copy of this order.
