(2) This is the second bail application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the applicant, who has been arrested in connection with Crime No.319/2015 registered at Police Station Bhatapara Gramin, District Baloda Bazar-Bhatapara, for the offence punishable under Sections 304-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

(3) The applicant's first bail application was dismissed on
