1. The ground of challenge against the transfer order is that even though the petitioner never made any application for transfer, impugned order shows that he has been transferred on his own request and representation has also been submitted by the petitioner in this regard.
2. It is either a mistake or an act of mischief. The allegations are serious and requires proper enquiry by the transferring authority. Let enquiry be conducted by the respondent / State through responsible officers into the allegations that

the petitioner never made application for transfer.

3. The decision on petitioner's representation shall be taken within a period of 30 days from today and appropriate order shall be passed. For a period of four weeks, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner to compel him to join at the new place of posting.
4. The petition is accordingly finally disposed off.
