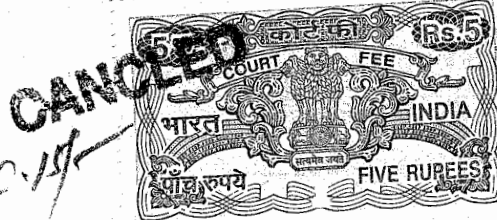

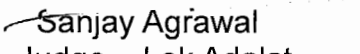

2. It is directed that the said amount be paid to the appellant without making any condition like fixed deposit and the said amount shall be paid to the appellant through cheque.

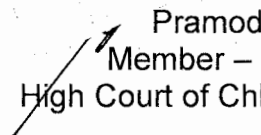
3. One of the claimants, i.e., respondent No.4 represented by Shri A.L.Singroul made a statement that he has no objection with regard to the said compromise.
