The accused/applicant has moved this bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for releasing him on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No.25/2015, registered at Police Station Kharora, Distt. Raipur, for the offence punishable under Sections 363, 366, 376 (2) (a), 306 of the IPC and Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.
