This is the second bail application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the applicant, who has been arrested in connection with Crime No. 356/2014, registered at Police Station Masturi, District Bilaspur, C.G., for the offence punishable under Section 20(B) of the N.D.P.S. Act.

2. The applicant's first bail application was dismissed on merits vide order dated 17/03/2015 in M.Cr.C. No. 1150/2015.
