This is office reference.

The matter is listed for orders on P.U.D. dated 21.03.2017 of the Additional District Judge (FTC), Jashpur, requesting for extension of six more months' time for final disposal of the case.

On 21.07.2016, this Court while disposing the appeal had directed the trial Court to decide the suit as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of eight months from the next date of hearing. By the PUD under consideration the court below has again prayed for six more months' time for disposal of the suit on the ground that the case is at the stage of appellant's evidence and the cross

examination has not yet completed.

The trial court is granted six more month's time from the next date of hearing to ensure disposal of the suit. The concerned Judge is directed to make all the endeavour for early disposal of the suit and if so required, she may give short dates to ensure the disposal of the suit within the time frame.
