1. This application under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. has been filed by the applicant apprehending his arrest in connection with Crime No. 51/2009 registered at Police Station State Economic Offence Wing/Anti Corruption Bureau, Raipur for offence punishable under 420, 467, 468, 471, 120 B, 34 of the IPC & 13 (1) (d) & 13 (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.
2. As per the prosecution case, applicant on the basis of forged experience certificate had obtained job of Shiksha Karmi Grade-II and thereby the person who were entitled to get job were deprived.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant has been falsely implicated in this case and it is still to be adjudicated whether the experience certificate was forged or not as without verification it is branded to be forged. It is further submitted that other co-accused namely Smt. Anita Sahu has been enlarged on anticipatory bail in M.Cr.C. (A) No.1070/2015 on 3/11/2015, therefore the applicant may be granted benefit of anticipatory bail.
4. Learned State counsel do not dispute the fact that similarly placed co-accused namely Smt. Anita Sahu has been enlarged on anticipatory bail in M.Cr.C. (A) No.1070/2015 on 3/11/2015 against whom the allegations were

like nature.

5. Taking into documents available in the case diary and the evidence collected so far and the fact that similiary placed co-accused namely Smt. Anita Sahu has been enlarged on anticipatory bail in M.Cr.C. (A) No.1070/2015 on 3/11/2015, I am inclined to extend benefit of anticipatory bail to the applicant.

6. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application is allowed and it is directed that in the event of arrest of the applicant in connection with the aforesaid offence, he shall be released on bail by the officer arresting him on executing a personal bond in sum of Rs.25,000/- with one local surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned Investigating Officer. The applicant shall also abide by the following conditions:-

- (i) that the applicant shall make himself available for interrogation before the investigating officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the applicant shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the applicant shall not act, in any manner, which will be prejudicial to fair and expeditious trial; and
- (iv) the applicant shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date given to him by the said Court till disposal of the trial.
