(1) The accused/applicants have moved this bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for releasing them on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No. 186/2014 registered at Police Station Narayanpur, District Narayanpur for the offences punishable under Sections 147,148, 149, 364, 302 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act.
