The accused/applicant has moved this bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for releasing him on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No.36/2014, registered at Police Station Chando, Distt. Balrampur-Ramanujganj, for the offence punishable under Sections 366, 313, 315 and 376 of the IPC.
