In view of objection taken by the State with regard to the maintainability of the petition on the ground of exhaustion of alternative remedy of revision under Regulation No.270 of sub-Rule 2 of Chhattisgarh Police Regulation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to prefer revision.
